



## **Comfort Kit Information**

For Elementary and Middle Students

Each campus has a trailer where emergency supplies are kept such as food rations, water and tents. Each elementary and middle student is asked to prepare a Comfort Kit which will also be stored in these trailers. They will be given out to the students in the event of an emergency, and are meant to help the children feel more comfortable as they wait for a parent or guardian to pick them up.

**Returning Grade 7 and 8 Students:** comfort kits were kept at the middle school for the summer. You may use this same comfort kit for this school year. You do not need to make a new one. If you need to update medication in the kit, please see Mrs. Jao at the office.

### Procedures:

**1. Fill a 27cm x 28cm Ziplock bag with items such as:**

- Family photo
- Comforting stuffy
- Tissues, bandades
- Emergency light stick, rain poncho, foil blanket (these items can be found in the camping section of stores such as Canadian Tire.)
- Small items to entertain such as a book, paper and pencil, crossword book or small toy.
- Small Bible
- Extra socks and underwear
- Toiletries

**Please do not include any food or drink items.** These can spoil, leak or cause allergy problems for other students. Emergency food and water rations are kept in our emergency supply trailer at each campus.

**2. Label the bag as follows:**
