CODE OF CONDUCT

At Richmond Christian School we seek through word and action to create an environment of trust and mutual support in which each member of our community can grow. There is an emphasis on the need to be sensitive to those we come in contact with so that each student can realize his or her individual, God-given potential. As a staff we are committed to the ongoing educational process of developing unique persons in a Christ-centered environment where faith is translated into action.

At Richmond Christian School we are members of a community. Mutual respect, cooperation and sharing are important values in any social experience. The ability to work with and for others is an important part of the learning process. In all we do, there must be respect for God and His Word, self, others, property and authority. Behaviour that would demonstrate a lack of respect, (cruel teasing, bullying, discourtesy, blasphemous language, vulgarity, vandalism, stealing, etc.) will be addressed so that the well-being and security of everyone in the school is ensured.

In general, the school does not attempt to supervise or control the out-of-school lives of its students. Even so, it is important for all students to live consistent, biblically-based, Christian lives wherever they are and in whatever they do. The lifestyle of the student affects their school work and their attitude toward other students.

The use of illegal drugs and alcohol violates Provincial law and is therefore prohibited. Students found to be involved with these substances, whether on or off campus, will be subject to disciplinary action ranging from suspension to expulsion.
